WHAT IS EL PASO COLLABORATIVE RAPID RE-HOUSING?

This program is a collaborative between the Opportunity Center for the Homeless and Endeavors to provide permanent housing assistance to individuals experiencing homelessness in El Paso, Texas and have been impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic.

WHAT ARE THE MAIN GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM?

El Paso Collaborative Rapid Re-Housing focuses on successfully exiting people out of homelessness during the Covid-19 pandemic by reducing the length of time program participants experience housing insecurity and limiting returns to homelessness within the first three months of program entry.

HOW WILL SOMEONE BENEFIT?

El Paso Collaborative Rapid Re-Housing will allow individuals to quickly exit homelessness, return to permanent housing, and focus on pursuing personal goals through a combination of temporary rental assistance and intensive case management.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE PROGRAM?

OTHER BENEFITS

- Eligible individuals will receive up to six months of rental assistance.
- Participants will be connected to supportive services and community resources.
- Solution-focused case management will be provided on a personalized basis.



El Paso Collaborative Rapid Re-Housing



We thrive in helping households (single adults or families) experiencing homelessness impacted by Covid-19.

People are provided with individual support to reach self-sufficiency, maintain permanent housing, and leave homelessness behind.



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HOW IT WORKS

FIRST STEP

Individuals meet with a case manager to start a Housing Stabilization Plan and begin the case planning process.

SECOND STEP

Housing identification begins as a pivotal point in the program, allowing participants to relocate near jobs or schools.

THIRD STEP

After a suitable rental unit is identified, rent and applicable deposits are processed for payment.

FOURTH STEP

The rapid re-housing program will provide household items to include furniture, utility activations, among other relocation activities.

FIFTH STEP

After a household is successfully placed, participants are engaged with case managers to connect them to services, such as employment, food access, benefits enrollment, financial counseling, physical and/or behavioral health care, legal services to name a few.

SIXTH STEP

After an individual is successfully placed, clients are engaged with case managers to connect them to services such as: employment services, food insecurity relief, benefits enrollment, financial counseling, behavioral health and legal services, among others.
